Speech Update – Spectrum currently has one virtual SLP, working with a small group of students. Another virtual SLP is awaiting her Ohio license to be approved. Once she comes onboard an additional 40-50 students will be served.

Title I Presentation – Ms. Lade and Mrs. Rosebush provided parents with the annual Title I presentation. Information shared was the scope of service, allocations and eligibility criteria. Questions were welcomed from the floor, none noted.

Autism Walk – Discussion was held regarding an Autism Walk to be held in April or May of 2024. A sign-up sheet was distributed for volunteers willing to serve on a committee. More details to be discussed at the November meeting.

Outside Raised Bed Garden – Students have expressed interest in an outside garden area. Parent, Sarah Layman, agreed to contact the local Boy Scout leaders and see if there may be an Eagle Scout in need of a community project. Mrs. Layman will report back at the November meeting.

Holiday Parties – Parents were invited to volunteer for classroom holiday parties. They were reminded a clean back ground check is needed before being in a classroom.

Gym Donation – A special thank you was given to parent, Dale Berthold for acquiring a \$1,000 donation from High Tech Pool, Inc. to be used for P.E. equipment. Mr. Berthold has reached out to a couple other local companies and is waiting for their decision. Discussion will be held at the November meeting as to what equipment will be ordered.

Talking Point – Spectrum is exploring the purchase of “Talking Point” a parent/student notification system. More details will be brought to the November meeting.

Music – Parents expressed an interest in having music in the classroom. Suggestions to contact local universities for students in need of practicum or community service hours was given. Mrs. Rimmele will report back at the November meeting.

Window Signs – Mrs. Rosebush will work with Infinity Schools on having the spelling corrected on the window signs.
